- 3) Party mix in a jar.
- 4) Create a cat from Rice Krispies (other edible materials can be used for decoration) **Judged on appearance only.**
- 5) 3 cookies – the same kind.
- 6) A decorated cupcake - **Judged on appearance only.**

**C. Ages 9 to 11 Years. (at fair time)**

- 7) Gingerbread person decorated.
- 8) 3 No Bake Cookies/Squares.
- 9) 3 Smartie or M & M Cookies.
- 10) A Decorated Birthday Cake – **Judged on appearance only.**

**D. Ages 12 to 16 Years (at fair time)**

- 11) 3 Chocolate Chip Cookies.
- 12) A Decorated Birthday Cake – **Judged on appearance only.**
- 13) 3 Muffins of 1 kind – named.
- 14) 3 No Bake Cookies/Squares.

**E. Ages 9 to 16 years. (at fair time)**

- 15) Butterscotch Confetti Squares (4 displayed on a plate)  
Recipe as follows:  
1 cup creamy peanut butter  
½ cup butter  
1 bag butterscotch chips  
1 250 ounce bag mini coloured marshmallows

½ cup Rice Krispies (optional)

In a large saucepan or microwave safe bowl, melt butter and peanut butter together over medium heat until blended.

Add butterscotch chips and stir until melted.

Let cool for 2-3 minutes and gently stir in the marshmallows and Rice Krispies.

Spread into greased 9" x 13" pan.

Cool in refrigerator until firm and cut into squares.
