


Section G – GARDEN PRODUCE



RULES:

DROPOFF & PICKUP:

- All entries are to be dropped off Thursday evening, prior to the fair, between 6 – 9 PM.
- Exhibit pick-up is Monday, after the fair, between 9am – 11AM. on the Monday after the Fair. Exhibits not picked up within two weeks of the Fair closing will become the property of the Society.

1	6 Beans: any variety (named), tip & calyx attached
2	3 Beets: any variety (named), tops trimmed to 1.3 cm
3	3 Carrots: any variety (named), tops trimmed to 1.3 cm
4	3 Ears Sweet Corn: 1/3 rd husk & silk removed, variety named
5	4 Cucumbers: pickling, 5-10 cm, stems attached
6	3 Cucumber: slicing, 15 cm and over, stems attached
7	3 Garlic bulbs: tops trimmed to 1.3 cm
8	3 Red Onions: unpeeled, tops trimmed to 1.3 cm
9	3 Spanish Onions: unpeeled, tops trimmed to 1.3 cm
10	2 Peppers: sweet, variety named, stems attached
11	2 Peppers: hot, variety named, stems attached
12	1 Zucchini Squash: stem attached
13	3 Tomatoes: table, variety named, calyx attached
14	3 Tomatoes: heritage, variety named, calyx attached
15	Tomatoes: cherry, 1 cluster, variety named

16	Tomato Plant: potted/patio, variety named
17	3 Potatoes: any variety (named)
18	3 Rhubarb stems: pulled, leaf trimmed to 5 cm
19	Herb Plant: potted, variety named
20	Garden Salad: A jar of edible flowers in water
21	Maple Syrup: Canada Grade A, colour named
22	Liquid Honey: grade and colour named

Please note: The winners in Classes 21 & 22 will be eligible to move on to a District competition and may qualify for the O.A.A.S. Provincial Competition.
