- 16) Butterscotch Confetti Squares (4 displayed on a plate)
Recipe as follows:
1 cup creamy peanut butter
½ cup butter
1 bag butterscotch chips
1 250-ounce bag mini- coloured marshmallows

½ cup Rice Krispies (optional)

In a large saucepan or microwave safe bowl, melt butter and peanut butter together over medium heat until blended.

Add butterscotch chips and stir until melted.

Let cool for 2-3 minutes and gently stir in the marshmallows and Rice Krispies.

Spread into greased 9" x 9" pan.

Cool in refrigerator until firm and cut into squares.
