Class ----- Description

A. Ages 4 and under. (*at fair time*)

- 1) Drip painting.
- 2) Hand painted stone.
- 3) Scribble monster.
- 4) Pom-Pom art.
- 5) Collect small things found in nature and place in an egg carton.

B. Ages 5 to 7 years. (*at fair time*)

- 6) Picture made from handprint and or footprint.
- 7) Make a snowflake.
- 8) Splatter painting.
- 9) Favourite animal using Play Dough.
- 10) Patterned necklace (pattern core must repeat 3 or more times).
- 11) Print the word *Lombardy*, decorate.
- 12) Make a picture using cupcake liners.
- 13) Paint a flowerpot.
- 14) Using cereal, make a flower on a paper plate and glue.

Special:

- 15) Build a Lego tower.

C. Ages 8 to 11 years. (*at fair time*)

- 16) Complete a directed drawing following steps from a video (e.g. Art For Kids Hub).

- 17) Make a musical instrument.
- 18) Build a LEGO farm vehicle.
- 19) One-colour artwork – entire piece using only shades of one colour.
- 20) Make and decorate a bird feeder.
- 21) Collage of all orange things (completely covered).
- 22) Create a card for any special holiday.
- 23) Paint a stone and add an inspirational word.
- 24) Printing: Lombardy fair is awesome because..... (copy and complete sentence starter).
- 25) Computer Art: Using any computer program, create a pretend ticket to the Lombardy Fair.

D. Ages 12 to 16 years. (*at fair time*)

- 26) Build a bridge out of popsicle sticks – is it freestanding?
Can it support a load (i.e. 500 ml unopened water bottle).
- 27) Design a thank-you card for a Lombardy Fair volunteer.
- 28) Make a wind chime.
- 29) Colour a picture from an adult colouring book.
- 30) Build any Lego scene and display in a box.
- 31) Make diorama of a farm.
- 32) Computer Art: Using any computer program, design an advertising poster for the fair.
- 33) Combine 3 or more different materials (e.g. buttons, paint, burlap) to create a country-inspired piece.
- 34) Paint or draw a rural themed miniature masterpiece (no bigger than 4' by 6").
- 35) Recycled Art Project – art made from any reused materials.

E. Specials: Ages 8 to 16 years. (*at fair time*)

*****Important: Exhibitor age must be on entry tag*****

- 36) Draw or sketch a single object on paper (black and white only).
- 37) Using watercolour, paint a landscape on paper.
- 38) Using acrylic paint, paint something of choice on paper or canvas.
- 39) Zentangle or doodle art on paper.

- 40) Abstract drawing or painting on paper or canvas.
41) Woodworking project.
42) Any Article of sewing or needle work crafts.
43) In cursive writing, copy the following poem (include the title):
